Applicants will be asked to respond to the following questions when filling out the electronic Student Ambassador application form found at the link above. We have provided these questions separate from the form, so applicants may review them before filling out their application. We recommend preparing your responses in a separate document before you begin to fill out the application. This helps ensure thoughtful responses to each question and helps prevent lost work as once you begin applying, you cannot save and return to your application. Applicants are encouraged to submit early, but all applications are due by **12pm (PT) on September 8, 2025**. Please keep responses to no more than 750 words in total (not per question).

1. What does community mean to you? Tell us about the communities in your life, and what it may look like to advocate for needs you see in your community.
2. What does advocacy mean to you?
3. How does storytelling show up in your life right now, and what role do stories play in our lives? (Conversations with loved ones, theatre, movies, television, books, the news, and many other things can be considered storytelling)
4. What do you hope to contribute to this program? What do you hope to learn?
5. Why are you interested in applying to a leadership program within a theatre organization?
6. Describe an experience you have had in which you played a leadership role or worked as part of a team to accomplish a challenging goal.
7. Tell us about a time when you've introduced a friend or family member to a new experience. Maybe you took someone to a new restaurant for the first time or showed your sibling how to ride a bike. How did you help that person feel comfortable and have fun?
